



Village of Key Biscayne's Kiteboarding Rules

1. All persons must annually register with the Village prior to operating a kiteboard within the Village.
2. Registration will expire May 31st of the following year.
3. Only registered persons may operate a kiteboard within the Village.
4. All persons shall possess and provide proof of an Up-Wind Level 3 International Kite Organization (IKO) certification.
5. All persons must maintain general liability insurance of no less than \$1,000,000 per kiteboarding incident for bodily injury and property damage. The liability insurance shall also include medical and dental coverage.
6. No person shall permit another person to utilize their Village- issued kite streamer.
7. All persons shall have attached the Village- issued kite streamer to his or her kite, while operating their kiteboard in the Kiteboarding Channel.
8. No person shall operate a kiteboard within the Village without a Village- issued streamer.
9. The Village Manager may establish temporary restrictions on kiteboard use due to holidays, weather conditions or beach overcrowding.
10. Kiteboarding instruction and certification assessment are prohibited within the Village.
11. All use of kiteboard equipment must take place within the Kiteboarding Channel.
12. Kiteboard lines may only be stretched out immediately prior to entering and returning from the water on the beach adjacent to the Kiteboarding Channel.
13. When a kiteboard is not in use all kiteboard lines must be wrapped around the kiteboard bar.
14. All kiteboards outside of the Kiteboarding Channel shall be contained within a kiteboard bag.
15. Any registered person shall only be permitted to body drag a kiteboard within the Kiteboarding channel.
16. Any violation of these rules will result in disciplinary action up to and including revocation of registration.
