
Project Overview

The Garden District's infrastructure will be enhanced to better withstand growing environmental challenges and meet the evolving needs of the community.

This stormwater drainage improvement project includes:



- Constructing three pressurized wells
- Converting one existing drainage well into a pressurized well
- Constructing a new stormwater pump station with backup generator in Domino Plaza Park
- Rehabilitating existing gravity wells within the District



The project will take place along Ocean Drive between East Enid Drive and Galen Drive. The existing gravity wells that will be rehabilitated are located along East Enid Drive and Sunset Drive.

Benefits

The Garden District Flood Mitigation Project is part of our Resilient Infrastructure and Adaptation Program, also known as Elevating Our Island Paradise. This is our Village's vision for preserving our community's quality of life from environmental challenges such as rising sea levels, flooding, and increasingly intense rain events. The resilience program consists of a series of immediate-relief and long-term projects that will help mitigate flooding, place our utilities underground, and protect our shorelines.

Start Date

This project is currently in the design phase. Construction is expected to begin in spring 2025 and scheduled for approximately one year.
